

High Horses TRAIN Progress Report July 2016 – June 2017

How much did we do?

Individualized GAS goals

177 written GAS goals were produced

EAAT participants

147 times, participants were provided with at least one GAS goal at the beginning of a session

On average, each participant was provided **1.2** rated GAS goals per session

EAAT instructors

5 instructors utilized GAS in EAAT sessions

1 instructors first started using GAS during this time period

Instructors wrote **8** individualized goals per session, on average

Data came from **6** different EAAT sessions (held between July 2016 and June 2017)

How well are we doing it?

Individualized GAS goals

153 (86%) GAS goals were independently rated

EAAT participants

131 (89%) times, participants received at least one rating on a GAS goal at the end of a riding session

For **20%** of the rated goals, raters felt that extenuating circumstances may have negatively affected goal attainment

EAAT instructors

73% of the rated goals included a participant session goal (or one provided by family members or care providers)

For **84%** of the rated goals, instructors provided some written instructions for leaders & side walkers on how best to support goal attainment on the GAS form

For **95%** of the rated goals, instructors suggested how gains in targeted skills may potentially carryover

Is anyone better off?

99 of 99 (100%) unique participants who participated in EAAT programs demonstrated gains in skills beyond their baseline performance on *at least one* of their goals during this time period

Assessments of participant performance in the targeted skill areas by independent raters indicated:

On **5%** of the goals, the participants demonstrated **no progress** beyond baseline in the targeted skill area

On **14%** of the goals, there was **some progress in the targeted skill, but less than was expected**

On **45%** of the goals, the **expected amount of progress** in the targeted skill area was demonstrated

On **16%** of the goals, participants demonstrated **better than expected progress** in the targeted skill area

On **20%** of the goals, the raters observed **much better than expected progress** in the targeted skill area
