



High Horses Non-Program Horse Service Guidelines

These guidelines pertain to the borrowing of High Horses' horses, both owned and leased to High Horses, for activities outside of regular program.

The service of each horse is subject to approval by the Equine Manager

The Equine Manager will approve the individual to work with the horse and that such service will not interfere with the horse's regular program role and will ensure that the horse has sufficient training to participate in said activity. The Equine Manager will ensure the physical soundness of the horse for said activity.

Requests to work with a horse should be made a minimum of one week prior to the activity to the Equine Manager.

The individual working with the horse will be given specific guidelines and precautions based on the horse's training, physical fitness and medical history.

If the guidelines are not adhered to this individual will no longer be permitted to work with High Horses' horse for non-program activities in the future.

Horses and equipment for said horses shall be returned to High Horses in the same condition they were borrowed.
