PARADE DETAILS & TIMELINE

A confirmation letter will be sent to you with more details but here is some information to get you started...

- ★ 12pm-1pm: Participants will gather at the staging area, at the Sunset Farm Building on Route 4, east of Woodstock. Packets with bridle numbers will be handed out upon your arrival and check-in.
 - ★ 1:00pm: Mandatory Parade Safety Briefing – a participant from each group must be represented
 - ★ 1:15pm: Judging will begin – judges will walk around staging area, so please be in costume and ready!
 - ★ 1:30pm: Parade Line-Up - participants will hitch and mount up in numerical order for the parade
 - ★ 2:00pm: Parade Departure from the staging area

- All stalls must be completely stripped prior to departure. Anyone who leaves a dirty stall will be billed \$50.
